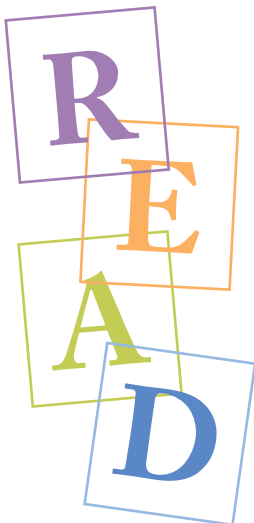


Building Blocks of Reading

- **Vocabulary** – Knowing the names of things.
- **Print Awareness** – Knowing that we read left to right; knowing how to handle a book.
- **Letter Knowledge** – Knowing that letters have their own sounds and are different from one another.
- **Phonological Sensitivity** – Knowing how to hear and play with smaller sounds in words.
- **Print Motivation** – Being interested in and enjoying books.
- **Narrative Skills** – Knowing how to describe things and tell stories.
