Angela Myers, current Chief Financial and Administrative Officer, will immediately assume the role as interim CEO. Angie brings 12 years of experience in our Library system and many more years of engagement in Mecklenburg County to this important role.

Board Chair Charles Thomas said, "We wish MT all the best as he moves forward, and we respect his decision. We thank him for his significant contributions at the Library during a period of tremendous growth." Thomas added, "We have great confidence in Angie Myers, a long-time member of our leadership team, who has accepted the interim CEO role as we continue to improve our Library system and move toward completion of the new Main Library."

The Board of Trustees will immediately begin the process of aligning a vision for the next CEO role and begin a search to identify top leadership candidates to serve as the CEO for one of America's preeminent library systems.

MT added, "It has been my privilege to serve this community during a period of growth, both in our physical footprint and programming. I am thankful for my time here and wish the outstanding Charlotte Mecklenburg Library staff and this community only the best as they continue this exciting journey."

The Library expects no immediate changes to its programming and continues its work to complete vital projects including the current library system software update and the new Main Library construction.
