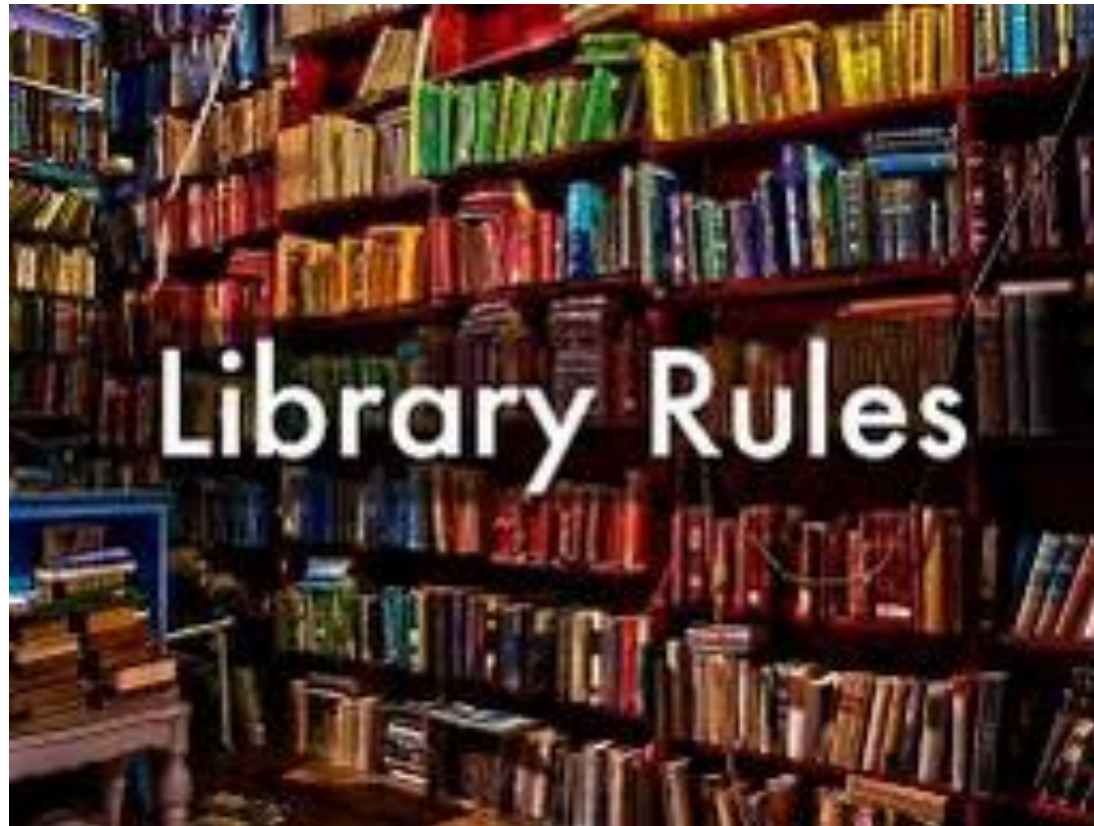


Library Rules
